Maintenance and care.

- * Always smoke the pipe completely down.
- * Keep the pipe free of coke cinders, the meerschaum will not burn like a briar pipe.
- * Never Soak the pipe inside with any kinds of liquid or cleaning preparation.
- * The surface of the pipe can be cleaned with a damp piece of soft cloth.
- Never keep your meerschaum pipe in a pocket together with keys or coins; scratches cannot be removed.
- * Please keep your pipe in its box or a cloth bag while you are carrying the pipe with you.

* Always turn the stem Clockwise when you

pull it of and put it on.

- * Never try to put an unoriginal stem on the pipe, this can cause permanent damage to the pipe. Please contact us for repair, should the need arise.
- * Finally, meerschaum is a delicate material, never knock the pipe against an ashtray, use a match to empty the pipe instead.
- * If you follow these simple rules, the meerschaum pipe will give you many years of unsurpassed smoking pleasure.
