HOW TO PLACE YOUR ORDER.

Use order sheet when placing an order — if not, please be careful to state number, finish and colour. Please write name and address in block letters, and state if it is your first order.

SHIPPING.

All goods are packed carefully and forwarded to any place. If you receive damaged goods or if something disappears during transportation you will be given full compensation. Please notify us immediately and return damaged articles and we shall be happy to make replacements.

POSTAGE. Only pipes by airmail

We pay the postage for all orders from \$ 5.00 and up, please enclose \$ 0.50 for orders of less than \$ 5.00. If you wish to receive the goods by airmail you must enclose \$ 1.00 for each parcel extra.

TIME OF DELIVERY.

Usually you will receive the parcel in about 4 weeks, and will be informed by your local post office on arrival.

We call your attention to the fact that anyone in the United States may receive gifts free of customs duty from foreign countries provided the total value of gift shipments in one day does not exceed \$ 10.00 (retail price \$ 15.00). Therefore, if the retail value of your order exceeds \$ 15.00 we arrange to send the order in several parcels. (All marked value under \$ 10.00).
